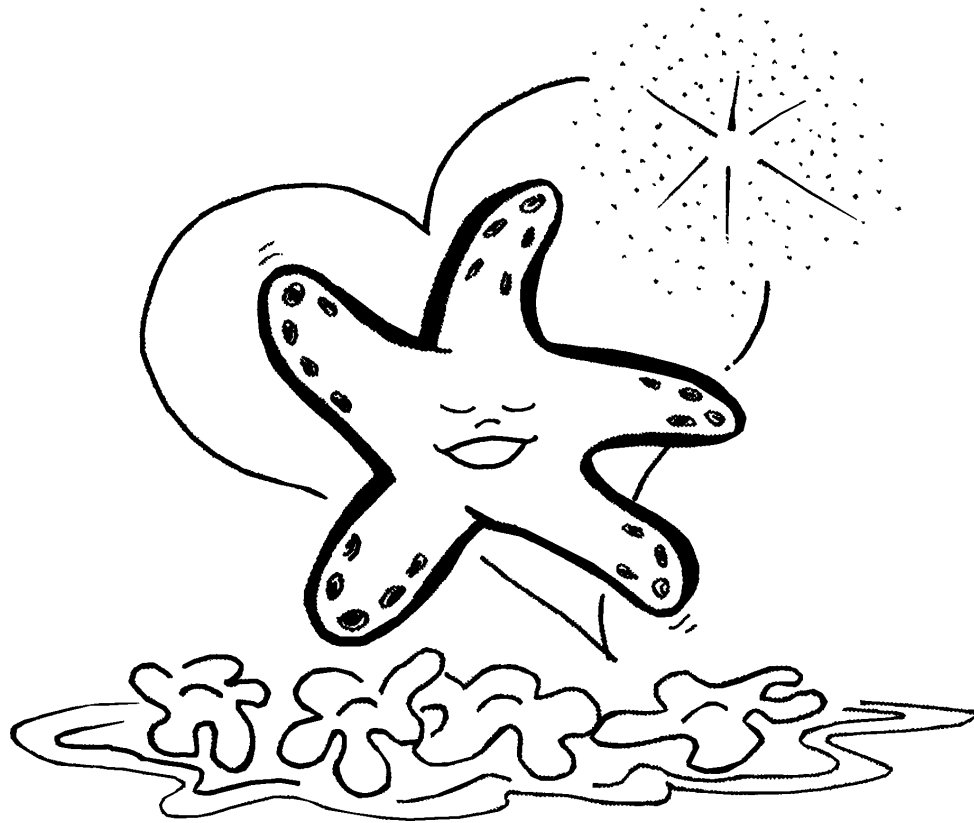
An old man was walking down by the sea, and he saw a young boy throwing things back into the water. He got closer and saw they were starfish. “What are you doing?” he asked the boy.
