



How to Make a Rod Puppet



- Draw a face on a cardstock oval.
- Use yarn, construction paper, or markers to add hair.
- Cut a little bit off the tip off the cardboard cone, then insert the shorter (8 inch) wooden dowel rod in the cone.
- Tape the face to the wooden dowel rod.



- Choose a color of paper for clothing and trace the clothing template on it.
- Then use glue to attach the clothing to the cone. If that doesn't work well, use tape.
- Use yarn, feathers, and markers to decorate the clothes and accessories for the puppet.
- To make arms, cut two 7-inch lengths of string.
- Tape or tie the end of each string to a longer (12-inch) wooden dowel rod.
- Tape the other ends of the string to the back of the cone.
- Now you can use the rods to make the puppet's arms move!

FINAL STEP:

Tape a copy of "Five Keys to ECK Mastership" inside the cone.
